Hard Rubbish Collections

The City of Marion has a hard rubbish program available to all residents. Each household can have a maximum of two collections per financial year. **Bookings are required** if you would like a hard rubbish collection. Please telephone the City of Marion Customer Service Centre weekdays from 8.30am to 5.00pm on 8375 6600 to arrange a booking.

Council will collect a maximum of one cubic metre (about a 6x4 trailer filled to the level of normal side heights). Excess material will be left and the resident will be responsible for the removal. Note that an expiation fee (fine) may apply as items left on public property constitute illegal dumping.

Items collected include:

- Household white goods, e.g. fridges, washing machines, stoves. Note: for safety reasons, fridge doors must be removed;
- Household furniture, e.g. cupboards, chairs, beds, mattresses. Double bed mattresses must be folded in half and tied securely;
- Scrap metal. Items such as free standing swings must be dismantled;
- Carpets and underfelt, **provided it is rolled up and securely tied and the rolls are no longer than 1.5 metres (5 ft) and no thicker than 30cm (1 ft) in diameter;**
- Electrical appliances;
- General household materials, e.g. doors, kitchen sinks, posts
- 250LT Hot Water Service
- Small amounts of wood providing it is tied up in manageable bundles
- Computer Monitors, TV's
- Single Roller Doors
- Glass (must be broken into small pieces and put in a box / container that is safe to handle and able to be lifted by one person)

If items are placed out in bags and/or boxes, they must be secure enough that they will not break open when either lifted or affected by rain etc. All items for collection must be able to be easily lifted by a single Council collector.

Types of items NOT collected:

- Car bodies, car parts and tyres;
- Building materials from the erection, demolition or renovation of a property;
- Brick, dirt, stone, tiles, concrete etc;
- Rainwater tanks, large steel scrap etc;
- Liquid waste or paint;
- Toxic substances such as batteries containing acid, ammunition etc;
- Vegetation;
- Kitchen waste;
- **Any item which may endanger the collection personnel**

Placement of items for collection:

- Place the item/s to be collected on the 'verge' section of the footpath (i.e. the area between the fence line and the kerb) in a neat and orderly manner, taking special care not to obstruct access to pedestrians;
- Items must not be put out until the Sunday prior to collection.

Please note:

Collector staff will NOT come onto private property to remove hard rubbish items under any circumstances. It is the responsibility of the resident to place the items on the verge.
