## Leisure

*The City of Marion, situated near to the city and the beach, offers a wide range of leisure and recreational activities for people of all ages.*

### Warriparinga

Surrounded by native flora and fauna, Warriparinga features a unique mix of Kaurna Aboriginal and European history. Places of interest include the Living Kaurna Cultural Centre, a Kaurna ceremonial meeting place and Fairford House with its adjacent buildings, heritage garden, vineyards and orchard. Pass through the Tjirbruki Gateway and walk along the network of paths and boardwalks to experience all that the 1.8 hectares of wetlands has to offer. ### Libraries
