Location

245 Sturt Road, Sturt 5047

- Behind the City of Marion Council and Housing SA buildings when coming from Sturt Road
- Behind the Nunkuwarrin Yunti building when coming from Diagonal Road

There are two paved walking paths from Sturt Road:

- One near the corner of Sturt Road and Diagonal Road
- One near the City of Marion Administration Building

Entrances

The main entrance has automatic doors. All entrances and exits are wheelchair accessible. The building has only one level, so there are no lifts.

Pets

Dogs are welcome in the outdoor areas. Assistant animals are welcome inside the building.

What to wear

Wear whatever makes you feel comfortable. The building floors and paths are flat. There is a slight slope from the paths to the car park, and part of the car park is gravel. Comfortable shoes are recommended.

Parking

- There is free parking onsite. You can enter the carpark at the Diagonal Road entry.
- There are two accessible parking spaces located at the back of the centre.

Public Transport – Bus

There are several bus stops near Cooinda Community Centre.

Stop 32 Diagonal Road – East Side

- About 100 metres from the centre
- Buses 200, 200B, 733 and 733A stop here

Stop 32 Diagonal Road – West Side

- About 110 metres from the centre
- Buses 200, 200B, 733 and N721 stop here

Stop 29D Sturt Road

- About 300–350 metres from the centre
- Many bus routes stop here

Westfield Marion Interchange

- About 550 metres from the centre
- Many bus routes stop here
- You can take the 733 bus from Zone C to Stop 32 Diagonal Road.

Public Transport – Train

Oaklands Park Railway Station is the nearest train station.

It is about 1.5 km from Cooinda Community Centre.

- Take the Seaford or Noarlunga train line
- Get off at Oaklands Park Station
- From the station, you can catch a 300 or G10 bus to Stop 29D Sturt Road.

Taxis

Taxi drop-off is located next to the accessible car parks located next to the entry pathway.

Café

- Cooinda Café is open weekdays from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm.
- Written menus are available on each table.
- Order and pay at the reception desk, then take your token to the café counter.
- Chairs can be moved to make space for wheelchairs, prams and mobility aids.

While the kitchen is open, so you may see, smell and hear food being prepared. You may also hear noise or music from programs in other areas of the centre. There are three outdoor tables with moveable chairs.

Toilets:

- Toilets are available during community centre opening hours 9:00 am – 4:00 pm.
- From the main entrance, walk straight ahead and then turn left to reach the toilets.
- The hallway to the toilets is wide and wheelchair accessible.

Facilities

- There is a female toilet and a male toilet, each with three stalls.
- There is also a gender-neutral accessible toilet.
- The accessible toilet door is an automatic sliding door with push-button entry and a button inside to lock the door.
- Grab rails are installed beside the toilet.
- The sink is wheelchair accessible.
