### Reception entrance

- Reception is located inside the Slade building, on Naldera Street.
- Reception has manual glass doors, these may be closed depending on the weather.
- Reception only has one level, so there are no lifts.

### Glandore Community Centre Grounds

- Glandore Community Centre is made up of 6 buildings that are connected by pathways with small slopes.
- Map of the grounds and buildings are located at each entry point on Clark Avenue, Naldera Street and Malwa Street.
- Set on well shaded grounds. Along the path there are many benches that you can stop and sit at.
- There is a mixture of concrete and brick pathways.
- There are two steps up to the gazebo and fountain.
- Rugby building has a gate with a child lock.
- Community garden has narrow pathways.

### **Pets**

Dogs are welcome in the outdoor areas. Assistant animals are welcome inside the building.

### **What to wear**

Wear whatever makes you feel comfortable. The building floors and paths are flat. There is a slight slope from the paths to the car park, and part of the car park is gravel. Comfortable shoes are recommended.

### **Café**

- There is a café inside the Naldera building called Summit Café Glandore.
- Summit Café is open Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday from 9 am to 3 pm. Hours may change during special events.

### **Community kitchen**

- Located inside the Slade building.
- Open to the public during centre opening hours.
- Instant coffee, tea and water available.

### Parking

- There is free parking onsite.
- Glandore community centre has two carparks.
- There is a carpark on Clark Avenue with two accessible parking spaces available.
- There is a carpark on Malwa Street with two accessible parking spaces available.
- There is street parking available on Clark Avenue, Naldera Street and Malwa Street.

### Public Transport – Bus

The closest bus stops are:

- Stop 9 Beckman Street (East and West sides) – about 450 metres from the centre.  
Buses 241, 241A and GLN1 stop here.
- Stop 180 Cross Road (North side) – about 550 metres from the centre.  
Bus 100 stops here.

### Public Transport – Train

The closest train station is Emerson Railway Station. It is about 1 km walk to Glandore Community Centre.

Trains on the Seaford, Noarlunga and Flinders lines stop at this station.

### Taxis

Taxi drop off is located out the front of the Slade building on Naldera Street.

### Toilets

There are toilets in the Slade, Clark, Rugby, Malwa and Glandore building. Naldera and Malwa buildings do not have a toilet.

#### Slade building toilets

- Gender-neutral accessible toilet, with a manual door and grab rails.
- Female toilet with two stalls.

#### Clark building toilets

- Gender-neutral accessible toilet, with a manual door and grab rails.
- Female toilet with two stalls.
- Male toilets with two stalls.

#### Rugby building toilets

- Gender-neutral accessible toilet, with a manual door and grab rails.

#### Glandore building toilets

- Gender-neutral accessible toilet, with a manual door and grab rails.

### Public Toilets

Located behind the Clark building.

Open Monday to Friday 9 am to 4 pm, and Saturday to Sunday 9 am to 5 pm.

- Gender-neutral accessible toilet, with a manual door and grab rails.
- Female toilet with three stalls.
- Male toilet with three stalls.

### Playground

The Marie Gregan Playground is located on the Malwa Street side of the Community Centre.

- A concrete path from the Malwa Street carpark leads to the playground.
- The playground is not fenced.

### Playground features

- Bark chip softfall
- Scramble net
- Slide
- Two swings
- Rope tunnel
- Climbing wall

## Glandore Community Centre

### BBQ area

There is an accessible electric barbecue next to the playground. There is also a table with fixed stools.

- The stools do not have armrests or backs.
- There are three open spaces at the table for wheelchairs or prams.

### Community Garden

The Glandore Community Garden is open to the public Tuesdays from 9 am to 2 pm and Saturdays from 9 am to 12 pm

- The garden gate opening is 83 cm wide.
- The Malwa Street gate can open up to 4 metres wide.
- The path from the fountain to the community garden and Rugby Room is brick and 106 cm wide at its narrowest point.
- Some areas under the veranda are accessible, but other parts of the garden have narrow, winding and uneven paths.
