

Parking

- There is free parking at the centre.
- There are two carparks, one on Moreland Avenue and a second on Bradley Grove.
- The best parking space for Centre access is on Moreland Avenue.
- There are two accessible car parks on Moreland Avenue
- There is one accessible car park on Bradley Grove.



Public transport

Bus

- Stop 26 on Bradley Grove is the nearest bus stop.
- Buses W90 and W90M stop here.
- From the bus stop, walk along the right (northern) side of the building, past the tennis courts and football oval, to reach the main entrance.

Taxi

- Taxis can drop passengers off at the Moreland Avenue carpark, next to the building entrance.

Toilets

Downstairs

- Toilets are located near the basketball courts.
- There is also an accessible toilet with grab rails, an accessible sink and a shower.

Ground floor corridor

- There is a toilet and baby change room in the corridor on the right side of the building.

Upstairs

- Toilets are located in the foyer upstairs and can be reached by lift.

Outdoor toilets

- Public toilets are available outside near the lawn area on the right side of the building.

Community Kitchen

Coffee, tea, and hot or cold water are available in the Community kitchen. The Community kitchen is on the right after you enter through the main entrance.

Playground

There is a playground. It is open 24 hours a day and is suitable for children aged 0 to 12 years. The playground includes slides, swings, climbing equipment and shaded areas.
